Patrick serves as the Executive Director of the Louisiana Rural Water Association, located in the Town of Kinder, Allen Parish, Louisiana. He spent ten years in management with an oilfield equipment company and five years with an oilfield chemical company where he did water analysis and managed an industrial bag company. His career with Louisiana Rural Water began in December of 1990. During Patrick's employment with Louisiana Rural Water he has structured the Energy Conservation Program, which is funded by the Governor's Office of Rural Development, and is now being used by other rural water state associations across the country.
